

Privacy Policy

1. Introduction:

- 1.1. Privacy Policy Effective date: August.01.2020
- 1.2. 1.2. Art by Katarzyna Stasiak/Katarzyna Stasiak ("us", "we", or "our") operates the www.katarzynastasiak.com website (the "Service").
- 1.3. This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data when you use our Service and the choices you have associated with that data.
- 1.4. This policy applies where we are acting as a data controller with respect to the personal data of such persons; in other words, where we determine the purposes and means of the processing of that personal data.
- 1.5. We use your data to provide and improve the Service. By using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.
- 1.6. Unless otherwise defined in this Privacy Policy, terms used in this Privacy Policy have the same meanings as in our Terms and Conditions, accessible from www.katarzynastasiak.com
- 1.7. We use cookies on our website. Insofar as those cookies are not strictly necessary for the provision of our website and services, we will ask you to consent to our use of cookies when you first visit our website.
- 1.8. This policy does not address anyone below 18 years old.

2. Definitions

- 2.1. **Personal Data** means data about a living individual who can be identified from those data (or from those and other information either in our possession or likely to come into our possession).
- 2.2. **Usage Data** is data collected automatically either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).
- 2.3. **Cookies** are small pieces of data stored on a User's device
- 2.4. **Data Controller** means a person who (either alone or jointly or in common with other persons) determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal data are, or are to be, processed (under this policy that's us)
- 2.5. **Data Processor (or Service Providers)** means any person (other than an employee of the Data Controller) who processes the data on behalf of the Data Controller. We may use the services of various service providers (Wix, Paypal etc.) in other to process your data more efficiently.
- 2.6. **Data Subject** is any living individual who is the subject of Personal Data.
- 2.7. The **User** is the individual using our Service.

3. The personal data that we collect

- 3.1. We collect several different types of information for various purposes to provide and improve our Service to you.
- 3.2. Types of Data Collected Personal Data While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you ("Personal Data").
- 3.3. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to: Email address First name and last name Phone number Address, State, Province, ZIP/Postal code, City Cookies and Usage Data

- 3.4. We may use your Personal Data to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by following the unsubscribe link or instructions provided in any email we send.
- 3.5. We may also collect information how the Service is accessed and used ("Usage Data"). This Usage Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.
- 3.6. Tracking & Cookies Data Service. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Service. Examples of Cookies we use: Session Cookies. We use Session Cookies to operate our Service. Preference Cookies. We use Preference Cookies to remember your preferences and various settings. Security Cookies. We use Security Cookies for security purposes.
- 3.7. We collect the data to use it for various purposes, all relating to our service to you.

4. Data Use and Processing

- 4.1. We will only use your data for activities relating to our Service to you.
- 4.2. To provide and maintain our Service
- 4.3. To notify you about changes to our Service
- 4.4. To allow you to participate in interactive features, special promotions and giveaways, when you choose to do so
- 4.5. To provide customer support
- 4.6. To gather analysis or valuable information so that we can improve our Service
- 4.7. To monitor the usage of our service to detect , prevent and address technical issues
- 4.8. To provide you with news, special offers and general information about other goods, services and events in which we offer that are similar to those that you have already purchased or enquired about, unless you have opted not to receive such information

5. Retention of Data

- 5.1. Katarzyna Stasiak/ Art by Katarzyna Stasiak will retain your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes and enforce our legal agreements and policies
- 5.2. We will retain usage data for internal analysis purpose, but this is usually for a shorter period of time, unless this data is required for security and legal purposes.

6. Transfer of Data

- 6.1. Your data may be transferred to and maintained on computers outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ then those in your jurisdiction. All data provided is processed in the United Kingdom and in compliance with UK laws.

7. Sharing of Data

- 7.1. All data provided is used by Katarzyna Stasiak. In rare circumstances we may disclose your personal data to our insurers and/or professional advisers insofar as reasonably necessary

for the purposes of obtaining or maintaining insurance coverage, managing risks, obtaining professional advice (for example when posting your art, insurance, delivery company etc.)

- 7.2. Financial transactions relating to our website and services are handled by our payment services providers. For online payments *we use Wix Payments and PayPal*. We will share transaction data with our payment services providers only to the extent necessary for the purposes of processing your payments, refunding such payments and dealing with complaints and queries relating to such payments and refunds. - 7.3. In addition to the specific disclosures of personal data set out in this Section 5, we may disclose your personal data where such disclosure is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which we are subject, or in order to protect your vital interests or the vital interests of another natural person. We may also disclose your personal data where such disclosure is necessary for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims, whether in court proceedings or in an administrative or out-of-court procedure

8. Storing your Data

- 8.1. Security of your data is very important to us. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Some of the measures we take are most recent anti-virus software, password protections, two step verification methods on our online servers.
- 8.2. Please note that no way of online storage or electronic transfer can always be 100% secure, and although we use number of security measures we cannot guarantee 100% security. To protect your data you should also take reasonable steps to implement security measures. Some examples are up to date antivirus, only using secure networks, having two step verification methods as well as keeping strong passwords.

9. Your rights

9.1. Your principal rights under data protection law are:

- (a) **the right to access** - you can ask for copies of your personal data;
- (b) **the right to rectification** - you can ask us to rectify inaccurate personal data and to complete incomplete personal data;
- (c) **the right to erasure** - you can ask us to erase your personal data;
- (d) **the right to restrict processing** - you can ask us to restrict the processing of your personal data;
- (e) **the right to object to processing** - you can object to the processing of your personal data;
- (f) **the right to data portability** - you can ask that we transfer your personal data to another organisation or to you;
- (g) **the right to complain to a supervisory authority** - you can complain about our processing of your personal data; and

(h) **the right to withdraw consent** - to the extent that the legal basis of our processing of your personal data is consent, you can withdraw that consent.

10. Service providers

10.1. Google Analytics Google Analytics is a web analytics service offered by Google that tracks and reports website traffic. Google uses the data collected to track and monitor the use of our Service. This data is shared with other Google services. Google may use the collected data to contextualize and personalize the ads of its own advertising network. You can opt-out of having made your activity on the Service available to Google Analytics by installing the Google Analytics opt-out browser add-on. The add-on prevents the Google Analytics JavaScript (ga.js, analytics.js, and dc.js) from sharing information with Google Analytics about visits activity.
